Persuasive Essay

What to write about in a persuasive essay?

The goal of a **persuasive essay** is to convince readers. When **writing** the **essay**, you'll first need to state your own opinion then develop evidence to support that opinion. These reasons and examples (evidence) should convince readers to believe your argument

Persuasive Essay

Topics (to give you some insight)

- Should students be allowed to have phones in elementary and high schools?
- Should students have to wear uniforms?
- Should the driving age be raised to twenty-one?
- Should students be paid for having good grades?
- Should girls be allowed to play on boys sports teams?
- Should teens be able to buy violent video games?
- Should boys and girls be in separate classes?
- Should public schools begin the day with a silent prayer time?
- Should schools offer fast food options like McDonald's or Taco Bell?
- Should the government place a tax on junk food and fatty snacks?
- Should children have to use booster seats in cars?
- Should people have to get a license to become parents?

Persuasive

will be uses personal thoughts, feelings, and opinions to get point across

=> can use emotions to get point across

=> attempts to persuade the reader to change his/her mind or view and agree with the author

> does not present opposing


Argumentative

=> presents one side of an issue to the reader using facts, data, and research

=> must analyze informational text to generate a thesis statement

=> must analyze informational text to address the counterclaim

Persuasive Essay - Contents

There are many parts to a Persuasive Essay that need to be included:

- Topic Sentence/ Reason (hook at the beginning of each body paragraph)
- Evidence (2 pieces)
- Call to Action (in the conclusion)

Persuasive Essay - Topic Sentence / Reason (Hook)

- Each of the 3 body paragraphs have to hook the reader into convincing them that you know what you are talking about.
- Your Hook is the 3 reasons why you should follow along with the writer; or how they are going to convince you to believe them.
- For example, Wayne Gretzky is the best hockey player of all time. You need to provide a hook to convince the reader. I could say that is because he has the most points of any player ever
- Your hook is the topic of the paragraph. You are only allowed to talk about this <u>one topic</u> in each paragraph

Persuasive Essay - Evidence

- Your hook is your topic of each paragraph!!
- You need two pieces of evidence to support your hook:
 - Wayne Gretzky has 2857 points, almost 1000 more than 2nd place Jaromir Jagr who has 1921.
 - Wayne Gretzky has more assists 1963 than any other player has points

Persuasive Essay - Call to Action

Call to Action

The **call to action** which comes right before the end of a **persuasive** speech is where you clearly tell the audience a role they can play after they leave your talk. The **CTA** gives audience members concrete tasks to tackle, and these tasks are ones that must be completed in order to bring your ideas to fruition

I have given you my opinion and shown you the facts. You should support me in saying that Wayne Gretzky is the best hockey player. Gretzky, Gretzky, Gretzky!!!!!!!!!!

Persuasive Essay - Format

Paragraph One:

State your opinion/point of view and a brief description of your 3 reasons.

Paragraph Two - Four:

Detailed description of reason number one. Please be specific by giving facts or specific reasons to support your point of view.

Persuasive Essay - Format

Paragraph Five:

Summarize your thoughts. Call to Action!

Double check your spelling, punctuation, and capitalization!

Persuasive Essay – example

Demand Writing #1 - Think of an activity that you enjoy when you're not in class. You are going to convince someone else that this would be a fun activity to try. Write about how you would convince them, including how you take part in the activity and what makes it fun.

Persuasive Essay - example

These beaches (like Marine Park in Pouch Cove, Middle Cove Beach or Topsail Beach) are still plenty of fun to go to, and let me tell you why!

Persuasive Essay - example

While the beach is a marvelous place to be, you have got to <u>remember to bring everything you need</u>. The most important requirement is bring as many friends as possible. Going to the beach by yourself would not be fun. Since the beach is full of sand and rocks, bring those sandals or your feet will hurt.
